



Theatre Class Auditions for the 2017-2018 school year will be held Sunday, April 23 and Monday, April 24 at 4:00 pm in the HHS Auditorium. Interested students should select one of the two audition dates to attend.

Students wishing to audition should prepare according to the table below based upon the classes they would like to take.

<b>Descriptive Class Name / Course Name</b>	<b>Class Description</b>	<b>Audition Requirements</b>
Introduction to Theatre (Theatre Production)	Basic discovery of all aspects of theatre	No requirements. This is a non-auditioned class.
Beginning Acting (Theatre Production)	Learning the basic principles of acting	1 minute monologue
Advanced Acting (Theatre Production)	Honing acting skills, becoming familiar with the parts of a show, the class will perform a young audience show	1 minute monologue
Competition Class (Theatre Production)	Class will compete in a one-act show, required to take both A and B day, class will focus on rehearsal process	Prepare a 90 second presentation which includes both a monologue and an excerpt from a song. There will be a dance/movement call immediately following the audition period.
Technical Theatre I (Technical Theatre/Design)	Learning how to do costuming, make-up, set design, set construction, lighting and sound production	No requirements. This is a non-auditioned class.
Technical Theatre II (Technical Theatre/Design)	Advanced costuming, make-up, set design, set construction, lighting and sound production. Students will work on the competition shows and the Spring Musical.	Audition will consist of a Technical Theatre interview. No preparation requirements.
